

# BATTERIES AT YOUR BUSINESS IN BELLEVUE

## They shouldn't go in the garbage. What should you do?

Batteries come in different shapes, sizes and chemical makeup, many of which are comprised of materials like mercury or lithium which are considered dangerous waste under Washington state law.\*

Businesses are BANNED from depositing dangerous waste in King County Landfills.\*\* Batteries which may be dangerous waste include:

### BUTTON



Contain mercury

### RECHARGEABLES



Contain nickel, cadmium and lithium

### PRE-1996 ALKALINE



May contain mercury

## PLEASE DON'T PUT THEM IN THE GARBAGE! Recycling options include:

† Small Quantity Generators (SQG's) are those non-residential entities that never generate more than 220 lbs. (approx. 25 gallons) of hazardous wastes and/or not more than 2.2 lbs. (approx. 1 qt.) of certain extremely hazardous wastes per calendar month and never accumulates more than 2,200 lbs (approx. five 55 gallon drums) of hazardous waste, or 2.2 lbs. of certain extremely hazardous wastes onsite at any time. Businesses that generate hazardous waste, including batteries, are required to manage those wastes in accordance with local, state and federal law. **Small Quantity Generator (SQG)** businesses are allowed to recycle hazardous materials for free through the Local Hazardous Waste Management Programs.
