ORDINANCE NO. 3100

AN ORDINANCE accepting a gift of two parcels of real property located on N.E. Eighth between 160th Avenue N.E. and 164th Avenue N.E. from the Crossroads Foundation.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue hereby accepts as a gift from the Crossroads Foundation, two parcels of real property located on N.E. Eighth between 160th Avenue N.E. and 164th Avenue N.E. in the City, more particularly described as:

Lot 1, Short Plat No. 82-01, recorded under Recording No. 8202089001 in Book 30 of Surveys at Page 187, records of King County, Washington, ALSO

an undivided 45.8333% interest in

Lot 4, Short Plat No. 82-01, recorded under Recording No. 8202089001 in Book 30 of Surveys at Page 187, records of King County, Washington.

Deeds conveying said two parcels are attached and have been given Clerk's Receiving Nos. 7610 and 7611.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.




