

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3104

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of a Grant Amendment with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for funding of a project entitled "Stormwater Demonstration Project - Phase II".

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to accept a grant from and execute a grant amendment therefor with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for the following program: Stormwater Demonstration Project - Phase II.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said grant amendment.

Section 3. There has been established by Resolution No. 3184 dated October 2, 1978, as amended by Resolution No. 3621 dated September 16, 1980, a project within Grant Control Fund No. 164, to be known as the Stormwater Demonstration Project - Phase II, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The source of revenue for the grant amendment is:

U.S. Environmental Protection Agency \$45,000

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant amendment, Section 2 of the 1982 Budget Ordinance No. 3065 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received in excess of estimated revenues as a result of the herein authorized grant acceptance to the Stormwater Demonstration Project - Phase II, within Grant Control Fund No. 164, in not more than the following amount:

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>AMOUNT APPROPRIATED</u>
Grant Control Fund No. 164	\$45,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenues received from the sources specified in said grant award should be less than \$45,000, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.
