CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3195

AN ORDINANCE bringing the local penalty for consumption of liquor by minors and for supplying liquor to minors into accord with state law and adding a new Section 10.14.085 to the Bellevue City Code, and amending Ordinance No. 2100, Section 2 (part) and Bellevue City Code Section 10.14.090.

WHEREAS, the supplying of liquor to minors and the consumption of liquor by minors has been closely associated with several recent deaths of minors in traffic collisions; and

WHEREAS, Eastside law enforcement agencies have entered into a concerted effort to arrest and prosecute persons for supplying alcohol to minors and minors who consume alcohol contrary to law; and

WHEREAS, local penalties for such violations should be in accord with state law in order to successfully prosecute charges currently being filed, now therefore;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new section 10.14.085 is hereby added to the Bellevue City Code to read as follows:

10.14.085 Specific Penalties for Consumption and Supplying.

Every person convicted of violating BCC 10.14.070 or BCC 10.14.080, shall be punished, for a first offense, by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars, or by imprisonment not to exceed two months, or both such fine and imprisonment; for a second offense by imprisonment for not more than six months.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2100, Section 2 (part) and Bellevue City Code Section 10.14.090 are each hereby amended to read as follows:

10.14.090 Violation a Misdemeanor.

Any person who violates or fails to comply with any of the provisions of this chapter for which no penalty has been

specifically provided is guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be public emergency necessary for the protection of public health, public safety, public property or the public peace and shall be effective upon adoption by a majority plus one of the whole membership of the City Council.




