ORDINANCE NO. 3202

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of a Federal Aid Grant Award; creating a new project within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386; and amending Ordinance No. 3065.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3120, a project has been established in Grant Control Fund No. 386 for railroad crossing improvements at 108th Avenue N.E. (M-22); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3220, a project has been established in Grant Control Fund No. 386 for preliminary engineering and right-of-way work for Northup Way improvements, 108th Avenue N.E. to 148th Avenue N.E. (M-25); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3689, projects have been established in Grant Control Fund No. 386 for N.E. 40th Street and 148th Avenue N.E. signalization (M-36) and for Bellevue Way channelization on signal modifications (M-40); and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 3891, the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program for the City of Bellevue for the period 1982 - 87 was adopted and includes new project (M-44), N.E. 24th Street, Bellevue-Redmond Road to 156th Avenue N.E.; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is hereby authorized to execute a Federal Aid Grant Agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for the following project: N.E. 24th, Bellevue-Redmond Road to 156th Avenue N.E. (M-44).

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said Grant Award Contract.

Section 3. There shall be established a project within Grant Control Fund No. 386, to be known as the N.E. 24th, Bellevue-Redmond Road to 156th Avenue N.E. Project, in which all of said money shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall

have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate, anticipated sources of revenue for the N.E. 24th, Bellevue-Redmond Road to 156th Avenue N.E. Project grant proposal and acceptance are:

Section 6. Section 2 of the 1982 Budget Ordinance No. 3065 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenues received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues as a result of federal aid grants and acceptance authorized to the following projects within Grant Control Fund No. 386, and not more than the following amount:


Provided, however, that if the actual sources of revenue specified in said grant awards should be less than the amount specified, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

This Ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City and shall take effect and be in

force five days after the date of posting.


