ORDINANCE NO. 3217

AN ORDINANCE relating to the 1983 budget; authorizing and directing submittal of an application for, and execution of and agreement for, a federal aid grant for traffic signal interconnection and synchronization on 156th Avenue Northeast between Northeast 8th Street and Northeast 20th Street; creating a new project within the Grant Control Fund; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues; and amending Ordinance No. 3212.

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. 4106 authorized the City to enter into a contract with the State of Washington Department of Transportation for funding for engineering design of a traffic signal interconnection and synchronization project on 156th Avenue Northeast between Northeast 8th Street and Northeast 20th Street; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is feasible and desirable to construct said project; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of said interconnection and synchronization project is estimated to be \$93,700, including the cost of said engineering design; and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$93,700 is available in the form of a federal aid grant through the Department of Transportation, to pay for said project, including said design, and no City matching funds are required to be appropriated for said project; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to authorize the City to apply for a federal aid grant for said project, to authorize acceptance of such aid grant, to establish a project in Grant Control Fund No. 386, and to appropriate funds therein for expenditure on said project; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application for, and to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for, federal aid grant funds for a traffic signal interconnection and synchronization project on 156th Avenue Northeast between Northeast 8th Street and Northeast 20th Street, in the total amount of \$93,700 including the \$7,000 grant contract heretofore approved by Resolution No. 4106.

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Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 3. At the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project shall be established within Grant Control Fund No. 386 to be known as 156th Avenue Northeast Signal Interconnection and Synchronization Project, into which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate, anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is as follows:

Federal Aid Grant	\$93,700
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Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, Section 2 of the 1983 Budget Ordinance No. 3212 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues as a result of the federal aid grant herein authorized for the 156th Avenue Northeast Signal Interconnection and Synchronization Project within Grant Control Fund No. 386, in not more than the following amount:

Grant Control Fund No. 386 - 156th Avenue Northeast Signal Interconnection and Synchronization Project	\$93,700

Provided, however, if the actual revenues received from the sources specified in said grant award contract should be less than \$93,700, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be

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in force five days after the date of posting.
