CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3255

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying property located at 11227 N.E. 14th Street, 11216 N.E. 14th Street and 1418 112th Avenue N.E., as recommended by the Hearing Examiner.

WHEREAS, an application for reclassification of the property hereinafter described was duly filed with the appropriate City officials; and

WHEREAS, on January 13, 1983, a public hearing was held thereon before the Hearing Examiner upon proper notice to all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, on January 27, 1983, the Hearing Examiner recommended to the City Council approval with conditions of said reclassification of said property located at 11227 N.E. 14th Street, 11216 N.E. 14th Street and 1418 112th Avenue N.E. from R-4 to O, and has made and entered findings of fact and conclusions based thereon in support of his recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the findings of fact and conclusions of the Hearing Examiner and has determined that the public use and interest will be served by reclassifying said property; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Ordinance; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council adopts the findings of fact and conclusions based thereon made and entered by the Hearing Examiner in support of his recommendation to the Council in this matter, as set forth in "Findings and Recommendation of the Hearing Examiner for the City of Bellevue, In the Matter of the Application of Mr. and Mrs. Roy Skibo, Mr. and Mrs. Ron Turner, and Mary McShane Barker for a Reclassification, File No. HE-A 82-20."

Section 2. The use classification of the following described property is changed from R-4 to O, with conditions:

Lot 4, Block 6 of Burrows' East Side Addition, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 44 of plats, pages 84 and 85, records of

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King County, Washington; AND

Lot 2 and Lot 16, Block 4 of Burrows' East Side Addition, according to plat thereof recorded in Volume 44 of plats, pages 84 and 85, records of King County, Washington.

This reclassification from R-4 to O is conditioned on full compliance by the owners of said property and their heirs, assigns, grantees, and successors in interest with the terms and conditions of that certain Concomitant Zoning Agreement executed by Roy C. Skibo, Betty A. Skibo, Amie D. Lamarr, Ronald Frank Turner, Mary Elizabeth Turner and Mary A. McShane Barker, which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 8367 and which is adopted by reference into this ordinance as though it were fully set forth herein.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.


