CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3268

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of a proposal to and acceptance of a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; creating a new project within the Grant Control Fund; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues; and amending Ordinance No. 3212.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to submit a proposal to and to execute a grant award contract with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development for the following program: Community Development Block Grant Jobs Bill Program.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 3. There shall be established at the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project series within Grant Control Fund No. 164, to be known as the Community Development Block Grant Jobs Bill Program, in which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate, anticipated sources of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance are:

Department of Housing and Urban Development \$229,000

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, Section 2 of 1983 Budget Ordinance No. 3212 shall be and here is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues as a result of the grant proposal and acceptance herein authorized to the Community Development Block Grant Jobs Bill program within Grant Control Fund No. 164, in not more than the following amount:


Provided, however, if the actual sources of revenue specified in said grant award should be less than \$229,000, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.
