ORDINANCE NO. 3281

AN ORDINANCE creating additional projects within the Utility Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 369; specifying the source or sources of funding therefor; appropriating additional monies to said Fund; and allocating said additional monies among said additional projects.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Utility Capital Improvement Fund No. 369 the additional sum of \$904,000, from the following sources:

Water Utility Fund No. 444	\$854,000
Sewer Utility Fund No. 445	50,000

Section 2. The following additional projects are hereby established within the Utility Capital Improvement Fund No. 369 and the amount appropriated to said Fund by Section 1, above, is allocated among said projects in the amounts set out opposite each project:
