

CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3299

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of a grant award from and execution of a grant award contract with the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation; creating a new project within Grant Control Fund No. 164; and appropriating the amount of said grant award in said fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is hereby authorized to execute a grant award contract with the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation of the State of Washington for grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 for the Goldsmith Property Project.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said grant award contract.

Section 3. At the time of execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, a project shall be established within Grant Control Fund No. 164, to be known as the Goldsmith Property Project, into which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 5. The approximate, anticipated sources of revenue for the grant are as follows:

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award contract, there shall be and hereby is appropriated in Grant Control Fund No. 164 as a result of the grant acceptance herein authorized for the Goldsmith Property Project within said Fund, an amount not exceeding \$150,000. Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said grant award should be less than \$150,000, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.


Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of

Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.




