CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3314

AN ORDINANCE adopting a budget for the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1984; and setting forth the estimated revenues and appropriations.

WHEREAS, a preliminary budget has been filed with the City Clerk as required by law; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held by the Council upon the notice prescribed by law, at which time comments for or against any part of the budget were heard; and

WHEREAS, the Council has made adjustments and changes as it deemed necessary or proper; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The budget of the City of Bellevue, Washington, for the year 1984, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 9001, is hereby adopted by this reference in the aggregate total of estimated revenues and appropriations for all funds combined of \$ 84,218,755.

Section 2. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for each separate fund, as set forth therein, are:

Section 3. The job classifications and pay ranges for employees of the City, as set forth in the 1984 Compensation Plan, hereby adopted as part of the budget for 1984, and given Clerk's Receiving No. 8839, shall constitute the job classifications and pay ranges for such employees until changed by this Council.


Section 4. All employees who are members of a bargaining unit shall receive such pay and benefits as are provided for in the appropriate collective bargaining agreement.

Section 5. The Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Office of the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the three official posting places of the City, and shall take effect and be in force five days after the date of posting.
