CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3344

AN ORDINANCE providing for revised water service and water consumption charges and sewerage service charges for the Waterworks Utility of the City of Bellevue applicable within the boundaries of the Town of Yarrow Point.

WHEREAS, the Town of Yarrow Point, by Ordinance No. 285, has reduced its business and occupation tax on the privilege of engaging in certain businesses, including the provision of water and water service and the provision of sewer service, within said Town; and

WHEREAS, the Waterworks Utility of the City of Bellevue sells, distributes and furnishes water, and furnishes sanitary sewerage service within the Town of Yarrow Point, and is subject to said business and occupation tax; and

WHEREAS, it is therefore necessary and in the public interest that water service and consumption charges and sewerage service charges applicable within the boundaries of the Town of Yarrow Point be adjusted in an amount to reflect such reduction in the business and occupation tax; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Notwithstanding anything in Ordinance No. 3316 to the contrary, the sewerage service charges payable under Sections 2, 3 and 4 of said ordinance for locations inside the boundaries of the Town of Yarrow Point shall be 104.2328% of the appropriate charges for locations outside the City of Bellevue as determined under said sections.

Section 2. Notwithstanding anything in Ordinance No. 3317 to the contrary, water service and consumption charges payable under Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, and 7 of said Ordinance for locations within the boundaries of the Town of Yarrow Point shall be 104.3408% of the appropriate charge for locations outside the city limits of Bellevue as determined under said sections.

Section 3. The revised charges herein established shall apply to water and sewer services provided within the Town of Yarrow Point on and after March 1, 1984.


Section 4. This ordinance shall be published by posting it in the


