ORDINANCE NO. 3353

AN ORDINANCE appropriating additional monies to the General Capital Improvement Program Fund; specifying the source of funding therefor; and allocating said additional appropriation within the Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the General Capital Improvement Program Fund created by Ordinance No. 3223 the additional sum of \$1,246,000, from the following sources:

Urban Arterial Board Grants	\$ 631,000
Federal Aid Safety Program Grants	95,000
One-half Cent Gas Tax	100,000
L.I.D. Funds	159,000
Minor Right-of-Way Acquisition Funds	96,000
Private Donations	125,000
Capital Improvement Program General Funding Revenue	35,000
Interest Earnings	<u>5,000</u>
Total	\$1,246,000


