ORDINANCE NO. 3397

A ORDINANCE adopting a revised statement of policy in regard to reimbursable business expenses incurred while traveling on or otherwise conducting City business or providing a service to the City, and repealing Resolution No. 4037.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts that certain "Statement of Policy for the Reimbursement of Business Expenses" filed under Clerk's Receiving No. 9431, attached hereto, and by this reference fully incorporated herein; and, until amended by action of the City Council, said statement expresses the City's policy on and provides guidelines for the payment and reimbursement by the City of travel, subsistence and related expenses incurred by persons while conducting City business or providing a service to the City.

Section 2. Resolution No. 4037, as amended by Resolution No. 4365, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


