ORDINANCE NO. 3403

AN ORDINANCE creating a series of projects within the Utility Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 469; specifying the source or sources of funding therefor; and appropriating monies to said Fund.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Utility Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 469 the sum of \$7,076,000, from the following sources:


Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


