ORDINANCE NO. 3423

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of federal funding from Federal Aid to Urban Systems (FAUS); creating a new project within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386; and appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or her designated representative is authorized and directed to accept federal funding from Federal Aid to Urban Systems for the following project: C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-4, N.E. 24th Street from Bel-Red Road to 156th Avenue N.E.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said Federal Fund Agreement.

Section 3. There shall be established a project within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 to be known as N.E. 24th Street from Bel-Red Road to 156th Avenue N.E. (C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-4) in which all of said money shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or her designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the funding is:

Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 in not more than the following amounts:

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in said Agreement should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
