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CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3439

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying 1.7 acres of property (Site 3) located at approximately 153rd Avenue and N.E. 11th Street in Planning District F of the Crossroads Subarea.

WHEREAS, an application for reclassification of the property hereinafter described was duly filed with the appropriate City officials; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 1984, a public hearing was held thereon before the Hearing Examiner upon proper notice to all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 1984, the Hearing Examiner recommended approval of said reclassification of said property located at approximately 153rd Avenue and N.E. 11th Street in the Crossroads Subarea from R-30 to R-10; and made and entered findings of fact and conclusions based thereon in support of his recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the findings of fact and conclusions of the Hearing Examiner and has determined that the public use and interest will be served by reclassifying said property; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Ordinance; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council adopts the findings of fact and conclusions based thereon made and entered by the Hearing Examiner in support of his recommendation to the Council in this matter as set forth in "Findings and Recommendation of the Hearing Examiner for the City of Bellevue, In the Matter of the Application of City of Bellevue For a Reclassification, File No. HE-A 84-3" and as set forth in "Order Amending Conclusion" entered in said matter, dated November 28, 1984.

Section 2. The use classification of the following described property is changed from R-30 to R-10.

Lot 2 of City of Bellevue Short Plat 80-29, recorded under Auditor's File No. 8109239006, records of King County, Washington.

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Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


