CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3464

AN ORDINANCE fixing the salaries of City Councilmembers, and repealing Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1618, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1670, and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1705.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1618, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1670, and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1705 are each hereby repealed .

Section 2. City Councilmembers shall be compensated for services rendered to the City at the salary set forth below:

- A. Councilmembers whose terms of office commenced on or before the date of passage of this ordinance shall receive a salary during the balance of that term of office of \$400.00 per month.
- B. Councilmembers whose term of office commenced on or before the date of passage of this ordinance who are serving or hereafter serve as Mayor during the balance of that term of office shall receive a salary for serving as Mayor, in lieu of the salary set forth in subsection A., above, of \$500.00 per month.
- C. Councilmembers whose term of office commences after the date of passage of this ordinance shall receive a salary of \$750.00 per month.
- D. Councilmembers whose term of office commences after the date of passage of this ordinance shall receive a salary for serving as Mayor, in lieu of the salary set forth in subsection C., above, of \$900.00 per month.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five


