CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3466

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing acceptance of a Grant Award Contract with the Washington State Department of Ecology for the Phantom Lake Restoration Project, C.I.P. No. D-19; establishing a project within the Grant Control Fund; and authorizing expenditure therefrom.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Acting City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to accept a Grant Award Contract with the Washington State Department of Ecology for the Phantom Lake Restoration, C.I.P. Project No. D-19.

Section 2. There is hereby established within the Grant Control Fund the following project with appropriations in the designated amount; and the City Manager is authorized to expend funds for said project in said designated amount:

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in said Grant Award Contract should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated and authorized to be spent herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 3. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the grant proposal and acceptance is:






