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CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3523

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of an application and execution of a supplemental agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for federal funding from Federal Aid to Urban Systems (FAUS); amending Ordinance No. 3232; and appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Fund No. 386.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to submit an application and to execute a supplement agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for federal funding from the Federal Aid to Urban Systems for the following project: C.I.P. No. PW-I-4, Signal System Interconnect Project.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within Grant Fund No. 386 to be known as the Signal Systems Interconnect Project (C.I.P. No. PW-I-4) into which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said funds.

Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the project is as follows:

Federal Aid to Urban Systems (FAUS)	\$693,650
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Section 6. Upon execution and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Fund No. 386 shall be hereby amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Fund No. 386 in not more than the following amounts:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
System Interconnect Project (C.I.P. No. PW-I-4)	\$693,650

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Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said application should be less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 7. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


