ORDINANCE NO. 3579

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the establishment of fire lanes upon private streets or ways to assure immediate and safe passage of emergency vehicles; amending Section 16 of Ordinance No. 2533; and amending Bellevue City Code 11.26.090.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 16 of Ordinance No. 2533 and Bellevue City Code 11.26.090 are amended to read as follows:

11.26.090 Fire lanes authorized.

Fire lanes are authorized upon private streets or ways and upon streets and ways open to the public, where, because of congregating people, the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles, or the existence of any other physical obstruction, emergency vehicles may be impeded from safely and promptly responding to emergency calls or disasters. Pursuant to designation of such fire lanes by the City Council, administrative staff is directed to erect signs indicating such fire lanes. When fire lanes are designated and official signs are erected indicating such fire lanes, as authorized herein, no person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle or maintain any obstruction in any such designated fire lane.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty


