ORDINANCE NO. 3600

AN ORDINANCE accepting a gift of real property, adjacent to the proposed Goldsmith Park, for park purposes.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Bellevue hereby accepts as a gift from Ila E. Osborn, Genevieve Osborn, Vance LeRoy Osborn, Velma Frances Zwiefelhofer, Ernest Zwiefelhofer, Jewel G. Penner and Jack Penner that certain real property consisting of approximately one acre in the City of Bellevue, and more particularly described as:

The West 30 feet and the south 30 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W.M.; TOGETHER WITH the West 30 feet of the South Half of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 22; situated in the City of Bellevue, County of King, State of Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


