CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3639

AN ORDINANCE reclassifying 22 acres of property (Site 4) in the North Bellevue Subarea located at the northwest corner of N.E. 36th Street and 115th Avenue N.E.

WHEREAS, an application for reclassification of the property hereinafter described was duly filed with the appropriate City officials;

WHEREAS, on January 17, 1985, a public hearing was held thereon before the Hearing Examiner upon proper notice to all interested persons; and

WHEREAS, on January 22, 1986, the Hearing Examiner recommended to the City Council approval with conditions of said reclassification of said property located at the northwest corner of N.E. 36th Street and 115th Avenue N.E. in the North Bellevue Subarea from R-30 to R-20; and made and entered findings of fact and conclusions based thereon in support of his recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council concurs in the findings of fact and conclusions of the Hearing Examiner and has determined that the public use and interest will be served by reclassifying said property; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the requirements of the State Environmental Policy Act and the City Environmental Procedures Ordinance; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council adopts the findings of fact and conclusions based thereon made and entered by the Hearing Examiner in support of his recommendation to the Council in this matter as set forth in "Findings and Recommendation of the Hearing Examiner for the City of Bellevue, In the Matter of the Application of the City of Bellevue For a Reclassification of Property Identified as Site 4 to Implement the North Bellevue Subarea Element of Bellevue's Comprehensive Plan, File No. HE-A 84-2."

Section 2. The use classification of the following described property is changed from R-30 to R-20:


That portion of the Northeast quarter of Section 20, Township 25 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington lying Westerly of the center line of Interstate 405 (Primary State Highway No. 1); lying Northerly of the South line of Lot 4 of Bellevue Short Plat 80-07 recorded under Auditor's File Number 8006129001, records of King County, Washington and the Easterly extension of said South line to the center line of said Interstate 405 and

the Westerly extension of said South line to the center line of Northern Pacific Railroad; and lying Easterly of the following described line; beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 13 of Yarrow Bay Village Division 2 according to the plat thereof recorded in Volume 116 of Plats, pages 100 and 101, records of King County, Washington; thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said plat on the following nine courses; South 01°02'46" West 105.00 feet; thence North 88°57'14" West 51.75 feet; thence South 01°02'46" West 252.06 feet to a point of a tangent curve with a radius of 430.00 feet; thence Southwesterly along said curve to the right through a central angle of 43°07'14" an arc distance of 323.62 feet; thence South 44°10'00" West 300.00 feet; thence South 33°46'00" West 77.97 feet; thence South 24°03'00" West 110.00 feet; thence South 14°18'00" West 126.00 feet; thence South 20°00'00" West 118.50 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 1 of said plat; thence South 40°27'00" West 30.00 feet to the center line of 111th Avenue N.E.; thence North 49°33'00" West 236.99 feet; thence South 40°27'00" West 30.00 feet to the Northeast corner of Lot 59 of said plat; thence South 40°27'00" West 364.46 feet to the most Southerly point of said plat of Yarrow Bay Village Division 2; thence South 48°03'12" West 50.00 feet to the center line of the Northern Pacific Railroad; thence Southeasterly along said center line to the intersection of the Westerly extension of the South line of Lot 4 of said Bellevue Short Plat 80-07 and the terminus of said line.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


