ORDINANCE NO. 3708

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of reimbursement from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for storm damage on Federal Aid System Route M-2066.

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized to receive reimbursement in the amount of \$76,541.00 from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) for storm damage on Federal Aid System Route M-2066, N.E. 12th Street/Bellevue-Redmond Road between 100th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 24th Street.

Section 2. Upon acceptance of said reimbursement the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund unanticipated and future revenues in excess of estimated revenues in the amount of the reimbursement from FHWA herein accepted for Project M-51 within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386, currently anticipated in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 - Project M-51	\$76,541

Provided, however if the actual revenue received should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


