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CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3710

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City Manager to accept Federal Aid-Safety Program (FASP) funds from the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for the construction of a traffic signal and intersection improvements at 130th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 24th Street and to execute a supplemental agreement with the WSDOT; and amending the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 created by Ordinance No. 2475 by appropriating unanticipated and future revenue to that fund. CIP No. PW-I-21.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to accept federal aid grant funds in the amount of \$98,400 from the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) for the design and construction of a traffic signal and intersection improvements at 130th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 24th Street.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to sign a supplemental grant agreement with WSDOT and to spend such grant funds as authorized in such agreement.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant.

Section 4. The approximate amounts and anticipated sources of revenue for the project are as follows:

City of Bellevue Matching Funds from Arterial Street Fund	<u>9,840</u>

Section 5. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant agreement, the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 authorized by Ordinance No. 2475, as amended, is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund unanticipated and future revenues in excess of estimated revenues in the

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amount of the federal aid grant herein accepted for Project #PW-I-21, the 130th Avenue N.E. and N.E. 24th Street Project within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386, currently anticipated as the following amount:

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the sources specified in said grant agreement should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after its passage and legal publication.


