CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3719

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of an application and execution of an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Richards Road at S.E. 32nd Street; CIP Project #PW-I-7.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is hereby authorized and directed to submit an application and to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for federal aid grant funds currently estimated at \$79,920, but which may be more or less, for the construction of a traffic signal and other street improvements at the intersection of Richards Road at S.E. 32nd Street.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant

Section 3. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the project is as follows:

Washington State Department of Transportation Federal Aid Grant (FASP) - Fund No. 386, Project #PW-I-7, Richards Road/S.E. 32nd Street	\$ 79,920
City of Bellevue Matching Funds from CIP "general funding" revenues	<u>139,980</u>
Total	\$219,900

The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to expend monies in the total amount set forth in this Section 3 for construction of Project #PW-I-7.

Section 4. Upon execution and acceptance of said grant award agreement, the budget for Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 created by Ordinance No. 2475 and as amended is hereby amended by appropriating to that fund unanticipated and future revenues in excess of estimated revenues in the amount of the federal aid grant herein accepted for Project #PW-I-7, the Richards Road/S.E. 32nd Street Project within Grant Transportation Fund No. 386, currently anticipated as the following amount:

Grant Transportation Fund No. 386 - Project #PW-I-7 Richards Road/S.E. 32nd Street Project	\$79,920

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the sources specified in said grant award applications should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its passage and legal publication.


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
