ORDINANCE NO. 3789

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles, and restricting the parking thereof on the east side of 105th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 2nd Street to 260 feet north, in the City of Bellevue, Washington.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on the specified portion of the following street shall be restricted as follows:

105th Avenue N.E. Parking is restricted to two hours on the east side of 105th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 2nd Street to 260 feet north.

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




