ORDINANCE NO. 3800

AN ORDINANCE authorizing acceptance of Urban Arterial Trust Fund grant monies from the State Urban Arterial Board and expenditure of said funds for the acquisition of right-of-way and for the construction of 108th Avenue N.E./Northup Way to Burlington Northern Railroad, C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-21

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS.

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to accept grant monies from the State Urban Arterial Board for the acquisition of right-of-way and for the construction of 108th Avenue N.E./Northup Way to Burlington Northern Railroad, C.I.P. Project PW-R-21.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in the Urban Arterial Board Accelerated Development Project Agreement for Construction Proposal.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant funds.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for Project No. PW-R-21 is:

Section 5. Upon execution and acceptance of said Urban Arterial Board Accelerated Development Project Agreement for Construction Proposal, the budget for C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-21 shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the Urban Arterial Board grant funds herein authorized, to C.I.P. Project No. PW-R-21 in not more than the following amount.

Urban Arterial Board grant funds for right-of-way acquisition for construction of 108th Avenue N.E./ Northup Way to BNRR	\$550,000

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue received from the Urban Arterial Board should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


