## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3816

AN ORDINANCE changing the name of Northup Avenue in the City of Bellevue, Washington, to "116th Avenue N.E.".

WHEREAS, questionnaires were sent to local owners/residents suggesting that the name of Northup Avenue be changed to "116th Avenue N.E."; and

WHEREAS, a poll of local residents indicate one positive response and no negative responses for such a change; and

WHEREAS, all City departments unanimously support such name change; and

WHEREAS, said name change would serve the public convenience and welfare; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the designation of that portion of continuous roadway of Northup Avenue indicated on Map Exhibit 1 be redesignated as "116th Avenue N.E.".

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.


