CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3826

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles and restricting the parking thereof on 100th Avenue N.E. between Main Street and N.E. 13th Street, in the City of Bellevue, Washington, and amending Bellevue City Code 11.23.150.

WHEREAS, Bellevue City Code 11.23.150 prohibits parking on 100th Avenue N.E. between Main Street and N.E. 10th Street during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. daily except Sundays and holidays, and

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from property owners on 100th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 10th Street and N.E. 13th Street for the implementation of a "No Parking Anytime" restriction on said street because of spillover parking from commercial areas adjacent to the neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to impose a "No Parking Anytime" restriction between Main Street and N.E. 13th Street on 100th Avenue N.E. to establish a uniform parking restriction and to eliminate spillover parking from adjacent commercial areas; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code 11.23.150 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Seven a.m. to seven p.m. on 100th Avenue N.E.

Parking is prohibited on 100th Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 13th Street during the hours of seven a.m. to seven p.m. daily except Sundays and holidays.

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




