ORDINANCE NO. 3829

AN ORDINANCE regarding the hotel/motel special excise tax; amending the effective date of the tax; and amending Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3818.

WHEREAS, on August 3, 1987, the City Council enacted Ordinance No 3818 establishing a hotel/motel special excise tax; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3818 provided that the tax would become effective on the effective date of said Ordinance No. 3818; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to defer the effective date of the tax to January 1, 1988; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 3818 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. This special excise tax shall be effective from January 1, 1988 through December 31, 1988, and shall apply to any sale or charge made for the furnishing of lodging by a hotel, rooming house, tourist court, motel, trailer camp, and the granting of any similar license to use real property, during said period.


Section 2. Any and all liability of any taxpayer for hotel/motel special excise tax which may have accrued under Ordinance No. 3818 from the effective date of said ordinance to the effective date of this amendatory ordinance is hereby terminated, provided that any such taxes which have actually been collected by the City shall not be refunded.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




