CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3838

AN ORDINANCE limiting the discharge and sale of common fireworks; adding a new Section 23.10.1460 to the Bellevue City Code; and amending Section 21 of Ordinance No. 3376 and Bellevue City Code Section 23.10.1461.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Section 23.10.1460 is added to Chapter 23.10 of the Bellevue City Code, to read as follows:

23.10.1460. Fireworks - Period of Discharge. No person shall ignite or discharge any fireworks except between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on July 4th of any year.

Exceptions:

1. Public displays authorized by permit issued pursuant to RCW 70.77.260(2).
2. Use by a group or individual for religious or other specific purpose on an approved date at an approved location pursuant to a permit issued pursuant to RCW 70.77.311(2)(c) and (d).
3. Use of trick and novelty devices as defined in WAC 212-17-030, as amended, and use of agricultural and wildlife fireworks as defined in WAC 212-17-045, as amended.

Section 2. Section 21 of Ordinance No. 3376 and Bellevue City Code Section 23.10.1461 are amended to read as follows:

23.10.1461. Uniform Fire Code Section 78.102 amended - Fireworks Permits.

Section 78.102 of the Uniform Fire Code as adopted by this chapter is amended to read as follows:

"Section 78.102(a). No person, firm or corporation shall manufacture, sell, either at wholesale or retail, or store fireworks or engage in a public display of fireworks without first having obtained a permit issued pursuant to chapter 70.77 RCW (State Fireworks Law) and chapter 212-17 WAC (Rules of the State Fire Marshal Relating to Fireworks).

- "(b) Permits issued for the retail sale of fireworks shall restrict any authorized retail sales period to between the hours of 12:00 noon and 11:00 p.m. on the twenty-eighth day of June; between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. on the twenty-ninth day of June through and including the third day of July; and between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. on the fourth day of July
- "(c) Permits for the retail sale of fireworks shall restrict any authorized retail sales to persons 16 or more years of age. Sellers shall require proof of age by means of display of a valid Washington State Driver's License or photo identification card issued by the Washington State Department of Licensing. No other forms of identification shall be accepted.
- "(d) The chief may impose additional reasonable requirements consistent with chapter 212.17 WAC as a condition of the permit.
- "(e) The chief may summarily revoke any fireworks permit(s) for failure to correct a violation of rules or conditions."

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




