ORDINANCE NO. 3862

AN ORDINANCE authorizing execution of an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant and authorizing expenditure of said grant funds for the acquisition of rights-of-way for improvements to 140th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 24th Street and Bellevue-Redmond Road; CIP No. PW-R-13

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant for rights-of-way acquisition for the improvements to 140th Avenue N.E. between N.E. 24th Street and Bel-Red Road, CIP Project No. PW-R-13, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 13092

Section 2. The City Manager or his designee is authorized to receive monies and expend same as authorized in the agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designee shall have responsibility for the administration of said grant funds

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for Project No. PW-R-13 is:

Section 5. Upon execution and acceptance of said federal grant pursuant to said agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation, the budget for CIP Project No. PW-R-13 shall be and is hereby amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of receipt of said grant funds herein authorized, to CIP Project No. PW-R-13 in not more than the following amount:

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue received from the Washington State Department of Transportation should be less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.




