ORDINANCE NO. 3865B

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Business and Occupation Tax; amending the minimum tax requirements; and amending Bellevue City Code 4.08.100.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code 4.08.100 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.08.100 Minimum Tax.

Whenever a person engages in one or more business activities, and the combined measures of tax applicable to such business or businesses, less applicable deductions and exemptions, is not more than three thousand seventy-seven dollars in a quarterly period, he shall pay a minimum tax of four dollars for such quarterly period.

Section 2. Section 1 above shall apply beginning with the quarter starting January 1, 1988.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


