CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3866

AN ORDINANCE regarding the Business and Occupation tax; increasing the registration fee; and amending Bellevue City Code 4.08.110 (A).

WHEREAS, the present registration fee for the City Business and Occupation tax is inadequate to cover the administrative cost involved in processing registration applications; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase the cost of Business and Occupation tax registration to an amount which will cover such administrative costs; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Bellevue City Code 4.08 100 (A) is amended to read as follows:

4.08.110 Certificate of Registration.

- A. No person, whether subject to the payment of a tax or not, shall engage in any business or activity in the City for which a license fee or tax is imposed by this chapter without first having obtained and being the holder of a valid and subsisting certification of registration to be known as a "registration certificate," issued under the provisions of this chapter as hereinafter provided, and without paying the business tax imposed by this chapter. The fee or tax imposed for the privilege of engaging in business within the City shall be the fee or tax imposed by this chapter, and, in addition, the sum of Twenty-One Dollars as a registration fee, which shall accompany the application for the certificate of registration. Applications for the certificate shall be made to and be signed by the clerk on forms provided by the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.


