CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3881

AN ORDINANCE establishing a residential permit parking zone in the Surrey Downs neighborhood with restrictions of two-hour parking except by permit; and amending Section 4 of Ordinance No. 3581.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3581, adopted by the City Council on December 16, 1985, established a temporary residential permit parking zone on various streets in the Surrey Downs neighborhood with restrictions of two-hour parking, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit; and

WHEREAS, establishment of a residential permit parking zone in the Surrey Downs neighborhood will promote the City's goal of reducing commuter traffic by encouraging employees working in the CBD to carpool or use available transit and will have the beneficial effect of reducing congestion in the Surrey Downs neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, response from residents in the Surrey Downs neighborhood to the temporary residential permit parking zone has been positive and the residents now request that the temporary residential permit parking zone be made permanent to reduce commuter parking spillover problems from the adjacent CBD; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 3581 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 4. The parking restrictions and the residential permit parking zone program established by Ordinance No. 3581 shall be permanent subject to future City Council action.

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
