CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3888

AN ORDINANCE authorizing application for and execution of a grant contract with the Washington State Arts Commission for the 1988 Bellevue Jazz Festival.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized and directed to apply for and execute a grant contract with the Washington State Arts Commission to partially fund the 1988 Bellevue Jazz Festival.

Section 2. The City Manager or his designated representative is authorized to receive monies and to expend same as authorized in said Contract.

Section 3. The City Manager or his designated representative shall have responsibility for the administration of said contract.

Section 4. The approximate amount and anticipated source of revenue for the Client Services Contract is:

Washington State Arts Commission	\$5,000.00

Section 5. Upon execution of said grant contract, the budget for the Grant Control Fund shall be and hereby is amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the grant contract herein authorized, to the Grant Control Fund in not more than the following amount:

Bellevue Jazz Festival 1988	\$5,000.00

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in said grant contract should be less than the amount provided herein, the

amount appropriated herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said lesser amount.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
