CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3911

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of an application and execution of an agreement with the State of Washington Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant (Federal Aid to Urban Systems); appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 368; and authorizing expenditure thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to submit an application and to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant (Federal Aid to Urban Systems) for the following project: C.I.P. No. PW-I-40, design of Lake Hills Connector and Richards Road.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 368 to be known as Lake Hills Connector and Richards Road Project (C.I.P. No. PW-I-40) into which all of said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. Upon execution and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Fund No. 368 shall hereby be amended by appropriating revenue received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Fund No. 368 in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Federal Aid to Urban Systems Grant (Lake Hills Connector and Richards Road Project; C.I.P. No. PW-I-40)	\$130,000

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said application should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

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Section 5. The approximate amount and anticipated sources of revenue for the project is as follows:

General Fund	\$104,000
Arterial Street Fund	156,000
Developer Contributions	25,000
Federal Aid to Urban Systems (FAUS)	130,000
TOTAL	<u>\$415,000</u>

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


