## CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3912

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees for fireworks permits for the sale, manufacture, storage, or public display of fireworks and amending Section 3 of Ordinance 3669 and Section 23.10.137 of the Bellevue City Code.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3669 and Section 23.10.137 of the Bellevue City Code are hereby amended by amending Subsection 4.101(c) as follows:

23.10.137 Uniform Fire Code Section 4.101 amended - Permit Requirements and Fees

Subsection 4.101(c) of the Uniform Fire Code as adopted by this chapter is amended to read as follows:

"Subsection 4.101(c)

(c) Each required permit indicated by assignment of a time period code above shall have a fee of \$50.00.

Exceptions:

1. No permit fee shall be charged for No. 4, candles in No. 7, and No. 38.
2. Fees for fireworks permits (No. 16) shall be \$48.00 for permits for the sale of fireworks and \$100.00 for permits for the manufacture, storage, or public display of fireworks.
3. Except for sales of fireworks, fees shall be waived for governmental agencies and religious or non-profit organizations.
4. Activities requiring a permit with a time period code of UR that are in existence at the time of the adoption of this ordinance may have a permit issued prior to July 1, 1987 without payment of a permit fee."

Section 2. Except to the extent that Subsection 4.101(c) of the Uniform Fire Code is amended by Section 1 above, all other provisions of Section 4.101 of the Uniform Fire Code as amended by Section 3 of Ordinance No. 3669 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
