ORDINANCE NO. 3918

AN ORDINANCE appropriating grant monies received as the result of the acceptance of a Referendum 39 grant from the Washington State Department of Ecology and authorizing expenditure thereof.

WHEREAS, the City Council, pursuant to Resolution No. 4966, passed on January 19, 1988, authorized the execution of a Referendum 39 Grant Agreement between the City of Bellevue and the Washington State Department of Ecology and authorized the receipt of funds to carry out the initial tasks of Phase II of the Phantom and Larsen Lakes restoration projects; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate said funds to the Grant Control Fund and authorize expenditure of said funds; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Grant Control Fund for the following project the following designated amount; and the City Manager is authorized to expend funds for said project in said designated amount, pursuant to the terms and conditions of said Grant Agreement:

Referendum 39 Grant Agreement for Phantom Lake Restoration Project (C.I.P. Project No. D-19)	\$396,825

Provided, however, that if the actual amount of revenue specified in said Grant Agreement should be more or less than the amount provided herein, the amount appropriated and authorized to be spent herein shall be adjusted to be equal to said greater or lesser amount.

Section 2. The approximate total amount and anticipated source of revenue for Phase I and Phase II of the Project is:
