CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3923

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles; and restricting the parking thereof, on both sides of Lake Washington Boulevard between 112th Avenue S.E. and Newcastle Beach Park, in the City of Bellevue, Washington and containing a statement of urgency.

WHEREAS, it is desirable to impose a "No Parking Anytime" restriction on both sides of Lake Washington Boulevard between 112th Avenue S.E. and Newcastle Beach Park to discourage parking along the paved bicycle path and to encourage nonmotorized transportation by providing convenient, safe access to the park for bicyclists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, Newcastle Beach Park opened to the public on June 25, 1988; and

WHEREAS, in order to assure proper parking control for users of Newcastle Beach Park, it is necessary to immediately impose parking restrictions; and

WHEREAS, adoption of the ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on the specified portion of the following street shall be restricted as follows:

Lake Washington Boulevard. Parking is restricted to "No Parking Anytime" on both sides of Lake Washington Boulevard between 112th Avenue S.E. and Newcastle Beach Park.

Section 2. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. It is necessary that this ordinance become effective immediately in order to restrict users of the newly opened Newcastle Beach Park from parking on that portion of Lake Washington Boulevard specified in Section 1 herein in order to reduce traffic congestion on Lake Washington Boulevard and to encourage the use of non-motorized transportation to access Newcastle Beach Park.

Section 4. This ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; has been passed by unanimous vote of the City Council; and shall become effective immediately.




