CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3924

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles; and restricting the parking thereof, on 103rd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 1st Street, in the City of Bellevue, Washington; adding a new Section 11.23.190 to Chapter 11.23 of the Bellevue City Code and repealing Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1201 and BCC 11.23.190.

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from businesses along 103rd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 1st Street for the implementation of a "2-Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Sunday and Holidays" restriction to discourage persons from parking all day, yet provide parking for short-term parkers and retail customers in Old Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to impose a "2-Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Sunday and Holidays" restriction on 103rd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 1st Street to establish uniform parking restrictions in the area; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1201, codified as BCC 11.23.190, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Section 11.23.190 is hereby added to Chapter 11.23 of the Bellevue City Code to read as follows:

11.23.190 103rd Avenue N.E. Parking is restricted to two-hour parking only on 103rd Avenue N.E. from Main Street to N.E. 1st Street during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily except Sundays and holidays.

Section 3. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
