CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3926

AN ORDINANCE relating to the parking of vehicles; and restricting the parking thereof, on the south side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and 100th Avenue N.E. and on the north side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and a point 300 feet easterly of the centerline of 100th Avenue N.E., in the City of Bellevue, Washington; adding a new Section 11.23.180 to Chapter 11.23 of the Bellevue City Code; and repealing Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1275 and BCC 11.23.180.

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from businesses along the south side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and 100th Avenue N.E. and on the north side of Main Street from Bellevue Way westerly to a point 300 feet easterly of the centerline of 100th Avenue N.E. for the implementation of a "2-Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Sunday and Holidays" restriction to accommodate Saturday shoppers in Old Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to impose a "2-Hour Parking, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Sunday and Holidays" restriction on the south side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and 100th Avenue N.E. and on the north side of Main Street from Bellevue Way westerly to a point 300 feet easterly of the centerline of 100th Avenue N.E. to establish uniform parking restrictions in the area; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1275, codified as BCC 11.23.180, is hereby repealed.

Section 2. A new Section 11.23.180 is hereby added to Chapter 11.23 of the Bellevue City Code to read as follows:

11.23.180 Main Street. Parking is restricted to 2-hour parking only on the south side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and 100th Avenue N.E. and on the north side of Main Street between Bellevue Way and a point 300 feet easterly of the centerline of 100th Avenue N.E. during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily except Sundays and holidays.

Section 3. The parking restriction established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty days after final passage by the City Council.
