CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 3932

AN ORDINANCE relating to the establishment of a temporary Residential Permit Parking Zone in the Manor Hill neighborhood with restrictions of two-hour parking 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit.

WHEREAS, residents in the Manor Hill neighborhood have sent a petition to the City regarding the parking spillover in their neighborhood from commuters; and

WHEREAS, City staff has conducted an engineering and traffic investigation and has conducted surveys of the neighborhood to determine the citizens' desires as to the implementation of on-street parking policies; and

WHEREAS, City staff proposed to the residents of the Manor Hill neighborhood that a Residential Permit Parking Zone program be implemented for a six-month trial period to determine if parking problems may be reduced or eliminated; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the residents in the area favor the establishment of a temporary Residential Permit Parking Zone; now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking of vehicles on both sides of the streets listed below shall be restricted to two-hour parking from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday and holidays, except by permit issued pursuant to Section 3 of this ordinance:

10000 block of N.E. 13th Street
10000 block of N.E. 15th Street
1300 block of 102nd Avenue N.E.
1400 block of 102nd Avenue N.E.
1500 block of 102nd Avenue N.E.

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to any vehicle parking on the streets enumerated in Section 1 above when said vehicle has a Zone 4 permit sticker or decal issued pursuant to Section 3 herein, attached or affixed on or otherwise directly visible from the front or rear window of said vehicle.

Section 3. Zone 4 permits may be issued by the Department of Public Works to any resident residing on any street enumerated in Section 1 herein for each vehicle owned by said resident. Visitor permits will be issued to said residents, with said visitor permits being transferable from one vehicle to another. Said visitor permits may also be borrowed and lent between residents. All Zone 4 permits shall be issued pursuant to procedure established by the Department of Public Works which requires proof of residency and vehicle registration prior to issuance.

Section 4. The parking restrictions set forth in this ordinance and the Residential Permit Parking Zone program established hereby shall remain in effect for a period of six months from the effective date of this ordinance, unless modified earlier by Council action, and may be extended by the Council after such six-month period.

Section 5. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force 30 days after final passage by the City Council.
