ORDINANCE NO. 4007

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of an Interlocal Agreement with King County for a Flood Control Assistance Account Program grant to assist in financing the Coal Creek Upper Main Channel Stabilization Project; establishing a project within Grant Control Fund 164; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Fund No. 164; and authorizing expenditure thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Interlocal Agreement with King County for the purpose of obtaining a grant to finance the Coal Creek Upper Main Channel Stabilization Project in accordance with the Flood Control Assistance Account Program, a copy of which Interlocal Agreement is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 14377.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Interlocal Agreement.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within Grant Control Fund No. 164 to be known as Coal Creek Upper Main Channel Stabilization Project into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. Upon execution of said Interlocal Agreement and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 shall hereby be amended by appropriating revenues received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Control Fund No. 164 in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Flood Control Assistance Account Program Grant (Coal Creek Upper Main Channel Stabilization Project)	\$ 43,680

Provided, however, that if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said application should be more or less than the amount set

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forth herein, the amount appropriated shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 5. The amounts and anticipated sources of revenue for said Coal Creek Upper Main Channel Stabilization Project are as follows:

Flood Control Assistance Account Program Grant	\$ 43,680
Utility Revenue Bond Fund 491	\$102,000
Utility CIP Budget Fund 469	\$ 3,320

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 7. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.
