CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4042

AN ORDINANCE expanding the Residential Permit Parking Zone (RPZ) in the area surrounding Bellevue High School with restrictions of "2-hour parking 7 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday - Friday", to include certain portions of the east side of 108th Avenue S.E. between S.E. 2nd Street and S.E. 10th Street; and amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3955 and BCC 11.23.720.

WHEREAS, the City has received requests from locations surrounding Bellevue High School concerned with vehicles parking for extended periods of time, creating an inconvenience to them and safety concerns, and a survey conducted on 108th Avenue S.E. has shown a majority of residents support expansion of the existing RPZ in the area surrounding Bellevue High School to include certain portions of the east side of 108th Avenue S.E. between S.E. 2nd Street and S.E. 10th Street.; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 3935 and BCC 11.23.720 are hereby amended to read as follows:

11.23.720 Restricted Parking - Parking by Permit - Zone 3.

- A. Parking of vehicles on the designated portions of the streets listed below shall be restricted to two-hour parking from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. except Saturday, Sunday, and holidays, except by permit issued under subsection B below.
- o East side of the 200, 300, 600, 700, 800, 900, and 1000 blocks of 108th Avenue S.E. (minus 500' adjacent to the driveway access to Westwood Village)
 - o East side of the 300 block of 105th Avenue S.E.
 - o East side of the 400 block of 105th Avenue S.E.
 - o 200 block of 106th Avenue S.E.
 - o West side of the 300 block of 106th Avenue S.E. up to 333
 - o 10600 block of SE 4th Street
 - o 1000 block of 107th Avenue S.E.
 - o 10700 block of S.E. 10th Street

B. The parking restrictions established by Section 1 of this ordinance shall not apply to any vehicle parking on the streets enumerated in Section 1 above when said vehicle has a Zone 3 permit sticker or decal attached or affixed on or otherwise directly visible from the front or rear window of the vehicle.

Zone 3 permits may be issued by the Department of Public Works to any resident residing on any street enumerated in Section 1 herein for each vehicle owned by said resident. Visitor permits will be issued to said residents, with said visitor permits being transferable from one vehicle to another. Said visitor permits may also be borrowed and lent between residents. All Zone 3 permits will be issued pursuant to procedure established by the Department of Public Works which requires proof of residency and vehicle registration prior to issuance.

Section 2. The parking restrictions established by this ordinance shall be filed with and maintained by the City Clerk in accordance with Section 11.23.010 of the Bellevue City Code.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect thirty days after final passage by the City Council.




