CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4069

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of an amendment to a grant agreement with King County to provide additional funding for the City's recycling program; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Control Fund No. 164; and authorizing expenditure thereof.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 3949, the City Council authorized and directed execution of that certain King County Waste Reduction/Recycling (WR/R) Matching Grant Program Agreement with King County which was given Clerk's Receiving No. 13871 for the purpose of providing \$20,000 in grant funds for the City's recycling program; and

WHEREAS, King County has available an additional \$15,000 in grant funds to supplement the first year grant of \$20,000 to cover office and operating supplies, professional services, posters, conferences and workshops, printing and displays in connection with the City's recycling program; and

WHEREAS, the County also has available second year (1989-90) grant funds of \$35,000 to further fund the salary for a recycling coordinator, consultant fees, and other services and charges; and

WHEREAS, receipt of said additional grant funds would facilitate the continuing efforts of the City's recycling program; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Amendment No. 1 to the King County Waste Reduction/Recycling (WR/R) Matching Grant Program Agreement with King County (Agreement) to provide additional funding to the City for its recycling program, a copy of which Amendment No. 1 has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 14884.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and expend the same as authorized in said Agreement as amended by Amendment No. 1 thereto.

Section 3. Upon execution of said Amendment No. 1 and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 shall hereby be amended by appropriating revenues received during the current fiscal year in excess of estimated revenues, as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Control Fund No. 164 in the following amount:

<u>Description:</u>	<u>Grant Amount</u>
King County Waste Reduction/ Recycling (WR/RN) Matching Grant Program Agreement, Amendment No. 1	\$50,000 (\$15,000 of which is a supplement to the first year grant and remaining \$35,000 of which is a second year grant for the years 1989/1990)

Provided, however, if the actual revenue received from the source specified herein should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

Section 4. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after passage and legal publication.




