CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4109

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing execution of a contract with the State of Washington, Department of Health; accepting grant funds for the promotion of water conservation within the City of Bellevue water service area; establishing a project within Grant Control Fund 164; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Grant Fund No. 164; and authorizing expenditure thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to execute that certain Contract between the State of Washington and City of Bellevue, for the purpose of obtaining a grant from the Department of Health to promote water conservation within the City of Bellevue water service area, a copy of which Contract is hereby given Clerk's Receiving No. 15043.

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Contract.

Section 3. At the time of execution of said Contract and acceptance of said funds, a project shall be established within Grant Control Fund No. 164 to be known as Water Conservation Project into which all said monies shall be deposited.

Section 4. Upon execution of said Contract and acceptance of said funding, the budget for Grant Control Fund No. 164 shall be amended by increasing appropriated revenues, received as a result of the funding herein authorized, to Grant Control Fund No. 164 in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
Water Conservation Project	\$75,960

Provided, however, that if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said application should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

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Section 5. The amount and anticipated source of revenue for said Water Conservation Project is as follows:

State of Washington	
Department of Health	\$75,960

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.
