AN ORDINANCE accepting a donation of certain real property adjacent to Mercer Slough from Mark I. White and Marie A. White.

WHEREAS, Mark I. White and Marie A. White own land in the area of Mercer Slough which they desire to donate to the City; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.21.100 allows such a donation to be accepted by ordinance; now, therefore


THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to accept from Mark I. White and Marie A. White, husband and wife, a donation of the property described on that certain Deed of Gift, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 15223, in the area of Mercer Slough, for such public uses and such other public purposes as the City Council may determine.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days after its passage and legal publication.


