CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON

ORDINANCE NO. 4125

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing submittal of an application and execution of an agreement with the State of Washington Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant (Federal Aid to Urban Systems) for the construction of 140th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 24th Street to Bellevue-Redmond Road; appropriating funds received in excess of estimated revenues within Transportation Grant Trust Fund; and authorizing expenditure thereof.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to submit an application and to execute an agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for a federal aid grant (Federal Aid to Urban Systems) for the construction of 140th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 24th Street to Bellevue-Redmond Road, CIP No. PW-R-13, a copy of which agreement has been given Clerk's Receiving No. *15248*

Section 2. The appropriate administrative officials of the City are hereby authorized to receive monies and to expend the same as authorized in said Agreement.

Section 3. Upon execution of said Agreement and acceptance of said funding, the budget for project M46 - 140th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 24th Street to Bellevue-Redmond Road within the Transportation Grant Fund shall be amended by appropriating revenues received as a result of the funding herein authorized to Transportation Grant Fund in the following amount:

<u>Description</u>	<u>Amount Appropriated</u>
M46 - 140th Avenue N.E. from N.E. 24th Street to Bellevue-Redmond Road	\$767,709

Provided, however, that if the actual revenue received from the source specified in said application should be more or less than the amount set forth herein, the amount appropriated shall be adjusted to be equal to the amount actually received.

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

Section 5. The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Washington, Division of Municipal Corporations.




